DIRECTIONS

From Hwy 101 (north or south): Take the Grand Ave. exit in Arroyo Grande. Travel east through the Village of Arroyo Grande. At the three-way stop sign, keep to your right and follow the signs toward Lopez Lake. Take this road 5.5 miles to Talley Vineyards (on your left), 3031 Lopez Dr. Look for the adobe house on the hill and the green gazebo; our Tasting Room (above) is located just behind the adobe.

From San Luis Obispo: Take Broad St. to Tank Farm Rd and turn left. Tank Farm turns into Orcutt Rd. Stay on Orcutt for about 7 miles until it ends at Lopez Dr. Go left on Lopez Dr. Talley Vineyards is on the left side of the road about 1/4 of a mile after you turn left. Look for the adobe house on the hill and the green gazebo; our Tasting Room is located just behind the adobe.

The goal at Talley Vineyards is to produce estate grown wines of uncompromising quality that best reflect the unique characteristics of each of the Talley family's five San Luis Obispo County vineyards. Complete control over all phases of winegrowing is the guiding principle: from the planting of vines ideally suited to each vineyard site, to viticulture and winemaking that emphasize long term sustainability, low yields and minimal processing, to the gentle bottling of the finished wine.
